I am pleased to share with you the 22nd Annual Report of Gregorian Public School. As I read through the report you will notice that it was a great year for the school. This resulted partly from the effort from our staff in opening new avenues for students and partly from the eagerness our students showed to grab those opportunities. More than anything though, this was the result of the incredible foresight and leadership by our mentor H. G. Joseph Mor Gregorios. We all owe His Grace a tremendous debt of gratitude.

Before I begin, let me acknowledge the service and contributions of all the principals and staff who served this institution, which made the foundation of this school really strong.

Human Resources

We started the year with 1754 students and a dedicated team of 95 teaching faculty who sets a strong academic back up for students. In addition to this we have 10 part time teachers who impart coaching in specialized skills like yoga, chess, dance (classical and western), percussion stringed instruments, skating, swimming etc. 70 members of the non-teaching section set the school work like a clock.

Academic results

Gregorian Public School proudly acknowledges the feat of its exemplary students in grade X and XII of 2019-20.

Grade XII Science stream toppers were Sandra Maria Alan and Sterin Roy with 97% of marks.

Grade XII Commerce stream topper was Harry George with 97.8% of marks.

Grade X

140 students appeared for the AISSE, March 2020. Out of this, 88 students won distinction and 52 students scored above 90%. Topper was Vanshika N. Sundrani with 99%. 8 students got A1 in all subjects. Vidya Vijayan got 100% in Mathematics. Bhavya Anna Biju and Vanshika N. Sundrani scored 100% in Science.

Beyond the class room activities

At Gregorian, we aim to educate the whole child – academic training is only a part of the wider plan. Students from grade III to XI are given club activities as per their choice in 3 categories, according to their age. Once a month, generally a third Saturday they enter the school campus without books and acquire a skill they like. Hence the learning is complete 100% ! Students get to min

There is an Interaction with the resource people for the day, many of whom are our own parents. I take this opportunity to thank all those parents who hold our hands to make our club activities a grand success. The topics are wide and varied from Home Economics to cooking, journalism to web designing, movie makers and quizzing, stitching a button to making a welcome drink, sculpturing and art facts, washing and ironing to gardening. The activities include all kinds of sports – Table Tennis, Cricket, Volleyball, Football and Basketball.

Introduced '**Collectivity**' – a collective activity for the students of grade VI to IX. Monthly zero period will be given (2 hours) for these activities. It includes – Dramativity, Sensitivity, Inquisitiveness, Ingenuity, Heritage, Greenunity, Technovity and Writivity. These activities were uploaded in the CBSE video channel

Sports and Games

Sports and games are given due importance. Other than the time table wise allotment for PT and games, special coaching is given to promising players in basketball, football, cricket, swimming and chess after school hours. 'Vishal Cup' – Interschool Football and Basketball Tournament were held in 15th and 16th November 2019. Around 15 schools were participated in the Tournament.

Interschool competitions

The best method to hone the talents of our students is to let them rub their shoulders with the best ones in other schools. Our students took part in interschool cultural events and sports tournaments. Some of them came back as achievers too.

Major achievements are:

In the CBSE interschool Table Tennis Tournament conducted in Chalakudi, we won:-

- 2nd position (under 19 girls)
- 4th position (under 14 boys)
- 3rd position (under 17 boys)
- 2nd position (under 19 girls)

In interschool district championship, senior boys got 2nd position and junior boys got 3rd position. In Mini Cadet Category we one 3rd position. Senior girls got 1st position in doubles.

We were runners up in the interschool table tennis tournament conducted by Vidyodaya, Thevakkal. The prizes we won are:

- 1st position (sub junior boys)
- 2nd position (junior boys)
- 1st position (senior boys)
- 2nd position (senior girls)

We were 2nd runner up in the interschool competition (Crossroads) conducted by Global Public School, Thiruvaniyoor. Our students won many prizes for the interschool literary and cultural competitions conducted by different schools. Our senior students won prizes for Model making competitions conducted by Viswajyothi Public School. Our students were winners for different chess tournaments in different categories conducted by chess academy.
